The National Transportation in Indian Country Conference (NTICC®) is the premier annual gathering for tribal transportation professionals, federal agency partners, contractors, engineers, and consultants serving Indian Country. Now entering its 29th year, NTICC® is hosted by The Center for Tribal Transportation and brings together decision-makers from tribal governments, tribal transportation and transit departments, the Federal Highway Administration, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and private industry to advance roadway infrastructure development and roadway safety in tribal communities.

The 29th Annual NTICC® will convene at the Gila River Casino and Resort – Wildhorse Pass, in Chandler, Arizona, a fitting setting that honors the conference's mission of strengthening transportation infrastructure across Indian Country. Over five days, attendees will participate in technical sessions, training workshops, vendor exhibitions, and high-level networking with the people who plan, fund, design, and build tribal transportation projects nationwide.

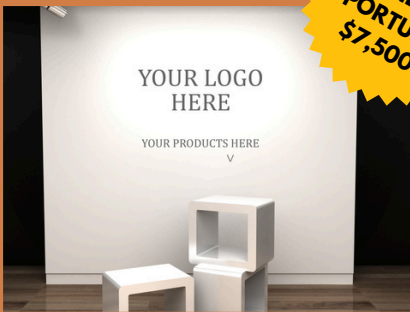

SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS

Shipping to Gila River Resorts & Casino Wild Horse Pass – shipping only accepted between November 11th to Event start. If shipment arrives sooner than November 11th, you may receive storage charges from Gila River Resorts & Casino Wild Horse Pass that will be your responsibility to pay. Packages will be held at Gila River Resorts & Casino and the Business Center will deliver them to your assigned booth for set-up on Sunday, November 15th.

Shipping from Gila River Resorts & Casino Wild Horse Pass is the sole responsibility of the Sponsor. You must create your own shipping labels and place them on the package. On event closing day Thursday, November 19th by 5:00pm sharp, Sponsor must take your labeled, packaged, and ready to ship boxes to the Gila River Business Center to be shipped out. Sponsors must call the specific carrier to request pick up for their shipments. If a return shipment has not been called in for pick up and is left on the property for more than 3 days after Event closing, the items will be relocated to the Lost & Found as abandoned property. 2026 SPONSORS TERMS AND CONDITIONS AGREEMENT November 15–19, 2026
I Gila River Resorts & Casinos – Wild Horse Pass, Chandler, Arizona Presented by
The Center for Tribal Transportation

1. BINDING SPONSOR TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The Exhibit Booth Application (the “Application”) and confirmation of acceptance of that Application constitute a binding contract between the Sponsor and The Center for Tribal Transportation (“CTT”), on behalf of the National Transportation in Indian Country Conference (“NTICC”), regarding the Sponsors use of exhibit space at the 2026 NTICC Annual Conference (the “Conference” or “Exposition”), November 15–19, 2026. By applying for exhibit space, the Sponsor agrees to be bound by all terms outlined in this Agreement, which are incorporated into the Application as if fully set forth therein, as well as all instructions outlined in the Sponsor Service Kit.

Any violation of these Terms and Conditions may subject the Sponsor, at the sole discretion of NTICC, to one or more of the following: loss of priority points for future NTICC Annual Conference booth selection; suspension of future participation privileges; or expulsion from the current Exposition. In the event of any such action, the Sponsor acknowledges and agrees that NTICC shall not be liable for any refund of booth fees or for any other expenses related to the Sponsors participation in the Exposition.

2. NATURE OF THE EXPOSITION:

The NTICC Exhibit Program is intended to educate attendees of the NTICC Annual Conference by providing information about products and services of professional interest to tribal transportation professionals. Exhibit booths are limited to organizations and agencies whose exhibits are consistent with the purpose of NTICC’s Exhibit Program.

3. LOCATION OF THE EXPOSITION:

The exhibit space is located at Gila River Resorts & Casinos – Wild Horse Pass, Chandler, Arizona (the “Facility”).

4. PAYMENTS DUE:

The schedule of payments is as follows. Failure to make payments does not release the Sponsor from its contracted or financial obligations:

- Upon submission and approval of the Application, payment is due upon receipt of invoice. Late charges may apply to balances unpaid within the terms specified on the invoice.
- All booth fees must be paid in full no later than September 1, 2026. Sponsors whose balances remain unpaid after this date may forfeit their booth assignment without refund.

5. CANCELLATION:

Any cancellation must be submitted to NTICC in writing. If the Sponsor cancels its booth space, the Sponsor shall, within ten (10) days of cancellation, pay NTICC the following percentage of the exhibit fee as liquidated damages and not as a penalty, based on the date cancellation is received:

Through June 30, 2026 - 0%

July 1, 2026 - August 31, 2026 - 50%

On or after September 2, 2026 - 100%

If the 2026 NTICC Annual Conference is canceled by NTICC, the Sponsor shall have the choice of either a full refund or a mutually agreed-upon credit toward exhibit space at the next NTICC Annual Conference.

6. ON-SITE SALES:

Sponsor information and materials must be educational, professional, or instructional in nature. The Sponsor may not engage in “over-the-counter” sales of goods or services for onsite delivery, nor in the taking of orders or the exchange of cash, checks, or credit cards for delivery at a later date.

7. ELIGIBLE SPONSORS:

Show management reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any company or product registering for the NTICC CONFERENCE.

8. ANTI-SOLICITATION AND UNAUTHORIZED MARKETING:

Sponsors and their representatives shall confine all promotional, marketing, and sales activity to the Sponsors contracted booth space. The solicitation of sponsorships, partnerships, or business engagements from other Sponsors, presenters, attendees, or sponsors anywhere on Conference premises — including session rooms, networking areas, hospitality spaces, hotel lobbies, and the Rodeo grounds — is strictly prohibited.

Companies intending to promote products or services at NTICC must register as Sponsors. Commercial vendors or consultants attending as guests of presenters, attendees, or sponsors shall not be permitted to solicit business. NTICC reserves the right to remove, without refund, any party found in violation of this provision.

9. GIVEAWAYS AND DRAWINGS:

Giveaways are permitted to the extent that they are professional and modest in nature. The permissible value of giveaways is at the discretion of NTICC and subject to the Sponsors sponsorship or exhibit level. Drawings may be permitted subject to prior written approval from NTICC. When permitted, there shall be no more than one drawing per day up to and including the final meeting day; no charge may be made for entry; and the value of prizes is at the discretion of the Sponsor per exhibit level. Any giveaways not distributed at the Sponsor booth must be approved by NTICC staff and must not disrupt the Conference. Alcohol giveaways are prohibited. Must label all Giveaways as a "DOOR PRIZE".

10. FLYERS, BROCHURES, AND COMPANY MATERIALS:

The Sponsor may provide educational and informational flyers and brochures to booth visitors, either by display on the Sponsors table or counter, or by direct distribution to attendees at the booth. Any materials distributed outside the assigned booth must be approved in advance by NTICC staff and must not disrupt the Conference. Alcohol giveaways are prohibited.

11. SPONSOR RESPONSIBILITY FOR PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT:

The Sponsor must have personnel present in its booth during all show hours. It is the responsibility of the Sponsor to ensure that all of its representatives are aware of and adhere to this Agreement and conduct themselves in a professional manner. The appearance and attire of any booth personnel or models must be professional at all times. All representatives of the Sponsor must be registered as Conference attendees or sponsors and shall wear identification badges furnished by NTICC at all times while in the Exhibit area. Placement of business cards over official NTICC badges, or any alteration of a badge, is prohibited.

NTICC reserves the right to restrict or limit the number of Sponsor representatives and to refuse service to anyone at its discretion. Any representative conducting themselves in a manner deemed unprofessional or disruptive by NTICC staff may be removed from the Exhibit Hall and from the Conference in its entirety. Any disruption caused by a removed party may result in legal action and/or removal from the Facility. All Sponsor and attendee fees are non-refundable.

12. SPONSOR HOUSING:

Blocks of rooms have been reserved for attendees and Sponsors. The Sponsor must submit guest names and credit card guarantees when booking lodging. The Sponsor, its employees, and its agents shall not negotiate blocks of hotel rooms directly with NTICC-participating hotels. The Sponsor may request hotel reservations through the online portal at nticc.org

13. SPONSOR BADGING:

The Sponsor is entitled to the number of complimentary badges specified in its contracted exhibit or sponsorship level. Additional Sponsor badges are available for purchase. A Full Access Sponsor badge provides admittance to the Exhibit Hall plus all workshops, sessions, meetings, and events (except invitation-only events). A Booth Staff badge provides admittance to the Exhibit Hall only. The Sponsor may request badges for its representatives by emailing conference@nticc.org. For attendee registration (individuals who are not Sponsors), please visit www.nticc.org.

14. DOOR DROPS:

Distribution of materials to attendees via hotel "door drops" is prohibited.

15. NTICC AND CTT LOGOS AND CONFERENCE GRAPHICS:

Except as expressly indicated in this section, the use of any names, marks, or logos belonging to NTICC or CTT is strictly prohibited. The 2026 NTICC Annual Conference graphic is available for use by the Sponsor subject to written approval by NTICC. Contact conference@nticc.org for artwork, specifying preferred width in pixels. A final copy of any item bearing the NTICC or CTT graphic must be submitted for approval to conference@nticc.org.

The Sponsor must clearly state on any item bearing the graphic that they are a Sponsor at the NTICC Annual Conference. Use of the graphic must not imply or infer that the Sponsor is representing NTICC or CTT, that any partnership exists with NTICC or CTT, or that NTICC or CTT endorses the Sponsor or its products or services. The graphic may not be altered in any way and may not be used as a header for a web page, email, or document.

16. HOSPITALITY SUITES:

Only confirmed Sponsors and Annual Conference sponsors are eligible to reserve hotel suites at the Gila River Resorts & Casinos for hospitality purposes. The Sponsor shall not reserve hospitality suites directly with the hotel. The Sponsor is not permitted to display equipment or products, or conduct product demonstrations, in suites or guest rooms during the NTICC Annual Conference.

17. PHOTOGRAPHY AND RECORDING BY SPONSORS:

The Sponsors employees, representatives, and agents may not photograph, video-record, or audio-record any other exhibit or Conference event except with the written permission of NTICC and the representative of any exhibit being photographed or recorded.

18. PHOTOGRAPHY AND RECORDING OF SPONSORS IMAGES:

The Sponsor agrees that the voices and likenesses of its employees, representatives, and agents may be photographed or recorded by NTICC or its agents for use in any media now known or hereafter devised in perpetuity, and hereby releases NTICC and CTT from any liability arising from such use.

19. AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT:

The Sponsor shall be solely responsible for complying with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) with regard to its exhibit space and shall be responsible for any claims arising out of the acts or omissions of the Sponsor or its employees or agents.

20. SAFETY AND FIRE CODES:

The Sponsor is responsible for knowledge of, and compliance with, all applicable union requirements and fire and safety codes.

- All exhibit decorations must be flame-proofed, and all hangings must clear the floor.
- All wiring on booths or display fixtures must meet underwriters' rules and standard fire department inspection. This applies to booth construction only and not to pre-wired electronic equipment.
- The Sponsor shall not use flammable fluids or materials of any nature, including any decorative materials prohibited by national, state, or city fire regulations.

21. INSURANCE AND LIABILITY:

The Sponsor shall be liable for any damage or loss to the Sponsors property resulting from theft, fire, accident, or any other cause. The Sponsor shall insure its own exhibit, equipment, display materials, and personal property. Neither NTICC nor CTT shall assume liability for any injury that may occur to the Sponsors employees, agents, or visitors.

22. SPONSOR INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

To the extent permissible by law, the Sponsor shall, at its sole cost and expense, procure and maintain current comprehensive general liability insurance against claims for bodily injury, death, and property damage occurring in, upon, or resulting from the leased premises. Such insurance shall include contractual liability and product liability coverage with combined single limits of liability of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate.

Such insurance shall name The Center for Tribal Transportation and Gila River Gaming Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Gila River Resorts & Casinos –Wild Horse Pass and their respective directors, officers, employees, volunteers, representatives, agents, invitees and guests as an additional insured. The Sponsor also shall maintain statutory Workers' Compensation insurance. All property of the Sponsor shall remain under its custody and control in transit to and from the Exhibit space.

NTICC reserves the right to cancel this Agreement if the Sponsor does not provide evidence of the required insurance coverage prior to the scheduled Conference opening date, in the form of a Certificate of Liability Insurance (ACORD 25) signed by an authorized representative of the insurer(s), submitted to conference@nticc.org as soon as practical, and in no event more than three (3) calendar days after request, time being of the essence. Auto liability and equipment coverage is required for all display vehicles and large equipment. (SEE ATTACHED SAMPLE WITH CORRECT VERBIAGE)

23. CONTRACTOR LIABILITY AND INSURANCE:

The Sponsor shall disclose to NTICC the name and address of each contractor or consultant retained by the Sponsor. The Sponsor shall further cause each such contractor or consultant to execute and deliver to NTICC at conference@nticc.org a liability statement under which each contractor or consultant shall be responsible for, and shall hold harmless and indemnify, The Center for Tribal Transportation and Gila River Gaming Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Gila River Resorts & Casinos –Wild Horse Pass and their respective directors, officers, employees, volunteers, representatives, agents, invitees and guests from and against all claims for personal injury or property damage arising out of such contractor's acts or omissions in connection with the Conference.

24. INDEMNIFICATION:

To the extent permissible by law, the Sponsor shall indemnify and hold harmless The Center for Tribal Transportation and Gila River Gaming Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Gila River Resorts & Casinos –Wild Horse Pass and their respective directors, officers, employees, volunteers, representatives, agents, invitees and guests, from and against any and all liabilities, damages, actions, losses, claims, costs, and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising from personal injury, death, or damage to or loss of property caused by or contributed to by any act, omission, negligence, fault, or violation of law by the Sponsor, its employees, agents, contractors, members, patrons, or invitees. The foregoing shall not apply to any liability, damage, or loss directly and solely caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of NTICC or CTT.

25. FACILITY:

The Sponsor is liable for any damage caused by the Sponsor or its agents, employees, or representatives to building floors, walls, or columns. The Sponsor shall not apply paint, lacquer, adhesive, or other coatings to building columns, floors, or walls, or to standard booth equipment or furniture contained in the Gila River Resorts & Casinos.

26. RESPONSIBILITY FOR PROPERTY:

Neither NTICC, CTT, nor Gila River Resorts & Casinos is responsible for loss or damage to the Sponsors property. It is the Sponsors responsibility to insure its property and personal items.

27. WAIVER OF RIGHTS:

Any rights of NTICC under this Agreement shall not be deemed waived in any manner except as specifically waived in writing and signed by an authorized officer of NTICC or CTT.

28. DISPLAY RULES:

The arrangement and appearance of items displayed are subject to approval by NTICC, which may, at its discretion, require replacement, rearrangement, or redecoration of any item or booth. No liability shall attach to NTICC for costs that may result from such actions.

29. USE OF SPACE:

Displays and demonstrations are limited to the confines of the Sponsors own booth, as is the distribution of literature and other items.

30. HEIGHT RESTRICTIONS FOR STANDARD IN-LINE BOOTH:

A standard in-line booth is one (5' x 10') or two booths (5' x 20') in a straight line. Exhibit fixtures, components, floral presentations, identification signs, and any other items in a standard in-line booth shall not exceed a maximum height of 8' in the back 5' of the booth, nor shall they exceed a maximum height of 4' in the front 5' of the booth. Structures designed to hold computers, monitors, televisions, video screens, or similar display elements and signs shall not be placed in the front 5' of the booth. Signage shall not be hung from the ceiling above in-line booths. Booth size is subject to the Sponsor level purchased.

31. HEIGHT RESTRICTIONS FOR ISLAND BOOTH:

An island booth is an exhibit space surrounded on all four sides by aisles. The entire cubic content of an island booth may be used up to the maximum allowable height of 20'. Any signage hanging from the ceiling must be located inside the dimensions of the booth, and the top of such signage must be no more than 20' above the floor.

32. RELOCATION AND FLOOR PLAN REVISIONS:

NTICC retains the exclusive right to revise the Exposition floor plan and to change Sponsor booth assignments at its sole discretion.

33. OBSTRUCTION OF AISLES OR BOOTHS:

Any demonstration or activity that results in excessive obstruction of aisles or prevents ready access to other Sponsors booths is prohibited.

34. CANOPIES AND CEILINGS:

Canopies, ceilings, umbrellas, and canopy frames shall comply with all booth-height restrictions. The base of any canopy shall be no lower than seven feet (7') from the floor, nor within five feet (5') of any aisle. Canopy supports for in-line booths shall be no wider than three inches (3"). Fire and safety regulations govern the use of canopies, ceilings, and other similar coverings. The Sponsor must verify compliance with NTICC staff and Gila River Resorts & Casinos.

35. MULTI-STORY BOOTHS:

Multi-story booths are prohibited.

36. CRATE AND CARTON REMOVAL AND STORAGE:

The Sponsor is prohibited from storing empty crates or boxes in its booth area during the show period. If the Sponsor uses the official show contractor, the contractor will remove empty crates or boxes that have been properly marked and identified, store them, and return them to the booth at the conclusion of the show. Additional charges may apply and are the sole responsibility of the Sponsor. Neither NTICC nor CTT is responsible for any such additional charges.

37. DEMONSTRATIONS:

As a matter of safety and courtesy to others, the Sponsor shall conduct any presentations or product demonstrations in a manner that ensures all Sponsor personnel and attendees remain within the contracted exhibit space and do not encroach on aisles or neighboring exhibits. The Sponsor is responsible for arranging displays, product presentations, and demonstration areas to ensure compliance. The Sponsor must obtain written permission from NTICC before demonstrating any product that is potentially dangerous to attendees. If permission is granted, the Sponsor shall establish a minimum setback of three feet (3'), install hazard barriers, and take any other actions required by NTICC to prevent accidental injury to spectators.

38. SOUND AND MUSIC:

Noise level must not disrupt the activities of neighboring Sponsors. Speakers and other sound devices must be positioned so as to direct sound into the booth rather than into the aisle. Sound and noise must not exceed 85 decibels when measured from the aisle immediately in front of the Sponsors booth.

If the Sponsor uses music, the Sponsor must ensure that licensing fees have been paid to the appropriate agency (e.g., ASCAP or BMI). Neither NTICC nor CTT is responsible for any licensing fees for music played in the Sponsors booth.

39. FIRE REGULATIONS:

All draperies, backdrops, bunting, and other decorations must be flameproof, and the Sponsor must possess a certificate of flame retardancy. All paper and other flimsy materials used for decorative purposes, including non-flameproof paper, are prohibited.

40. LIGHTING:

No lighting, fixtures, lighting trusses, or overhead lighting are permitted outside the boundaries of the Sponsor's booth. Lighting must be directed to the inner confines of the booth space and shall not project onto other exhibits or aisles. Lighting that is potentially harmful, such as lasers or ultraviolet lighting, is prohibited. Lighting that spins, rotates, flashes, or pulsates is expressly prohibited.

41. DISPLAY VEHICLES AND LARGE EQUIPMENT:

All display vehicles and equipment must be pre approved by NTICC and are subject to Gila River Resorts & Casinos guidelines. Loading and unloading of approved vehicles and equipment is the responsibility of the Sponsor and must occur only during the dates and times authorized by NTICC without disrupting the Conference. Complete details of any display vehicle or equipment, along with additional insurance documentation, must be submitted to Exhibitor@nticc.org along with Proof of Insurance IN ADVANCE FOR PRE-APPROVAL.

42. OUTDOOR SPACE:

Exhibits outside the NTICC official Exhibit Hall are expressly prohibited and shall be shut down. This includes vehicles and equipment, whether displayed or intended to promote, parked or idling at the meeting property, that are not approved by NTICC.

43. COMPLIANCE WITH DISPLAY RULES:

If the Sponsors booth does not comply with any of the display rules set forth herein, NTICC reserves the right to direct the official show contractor to modify the Sponsors booth to comply, at the Sponsors expense.

44. NO SMOKING OR VAPING:

The use of tobacco products, including vaping devices, is prohibited in the Gila River Resorts & Casinos convention center.

45. NOISE, LIGHT, AND ODORS:

Noisy or obstructive work is not permitted during open hours of the exhibit areas, nor are noisily operating displays, overly bright or distracting lights, or exhibits producing objectionable odors. NTICC shall have sole discretion in determining what is noisy, overly bright, distracting, obstructive, or objectionable.

46. FLOOR LOADING:

Under no circumstances shall the weight of any equipment or exhibit material exceed the specified floor load limit of the Exhibit Hall. The Sponsor accepts full and sole responsibility for injury or damage to property or persons resulting from failure, knowingly or otherwise, to distribute exhibit material and products in conformity with the maximum floor load specifications.

47. INSTALLING, EXHIBITING, AND DISMANTLING:

Hours and dates for installing, exhibiting, and dismantling shall be those specified by NTICC. The Sponsor shall be liable for all storage and handling charges resulting from failure to remove exhibit material from the Exposition before the specified conclusion of the dismantling period. Only official contractors, Sponsor-appointed contractors, and the Sponsors employees are permitted on the show floor during move-in and move-out; no one under the age of eighteen (18) is permitted on the show floor during those times. Sponsor booths that leave the Conference earlier than the final Conference date listed in this Agreement will be subject to penalty charges for early dismantling.

48. SHARED SPACE OF SPONSORSHIPS:

Sponsorships and Exhibiting packages are designed for ONE company. If you decide to partner with another company to share the space and/or cost, please note that only ONE company will be noted as the registered vendor, only one company will receive the benefits such as logo placement, business description and contact listed, signage, etc. If you choose to partner up, please note NTICC will not “split” these benefits.

49. SUBLEASING OF BOOTH SPACE:

The Sponsor may not sublet its exhibit space or any part thereof, nor exhibit, offer for sale, or advertise articles not manufactured or sold by the exhibiting company, except where such articles are necessary for the proper demonstration or operation of the Sponsors display, in which case identification shall be limited to the manufacturer’s normal regular nameplate. The Sponsor shall not permit representatives of other companies to operate from its booth. Determinations of NTICC shall, in all instances, be final with regard to use of exhibit space. All Sponsor booth space is non-refundable.

50. OCCUPANCY DEFAULT:

If the Sponsor fails to occupy contracted space, the Sponsor shall not be relieved of the obligation to pay the full rental charge for such space. The Sponsors booth must be fully installed no later than three (3) hours prior to show opening, or per written approval by NTICC. If the booth is not set up by that time, NTICC reserves the right to direct the official service contractor to set up the exhibit at the sole expense of the Sponsor, or to make such other use of the space as NTICC deems necessary, with no refund to the Sponsor. The Sponsor shall not begin dismantling before the official closing of the Exposition. Penalty fees may apply to any early dismantling at NTICC’s discretion.

51. PROHIBITED ITEMS:

The following are expressly prohibited in the Exposition: flammable or non flammable compressed gases, helium-filled balloons, live animals (except service animals), birdseed, glitter, confetti, adhesive-backed decals, open flames, flammable or combustible liquids or materials, hazardous chemicals and materials, explosives, blasting agents, and any other materials prohibited by law or by Gila River Resorts & Casinos. The Sponsor assumes full responsibility for any costs or liabilities resulting from failure to comply with these prohibitions.

52. ADMITTANCE DURING NON-SHOW HOURS:

With the exception of posted setup and move-out times, the Sponsor may not enter the Exhibit Hall more than one (1) hour prior to Exposition opening, nor remain in the Hall after the Exposition closes each day.

53. ELIGIBILITY:

NTICC has the sole right to determine the eligibility of any company or product for inclusion in the Exposition. NTICC reserves the right to refuse service to any Sponsor.

54. COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAWS AND HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

The Sponsor agrees that it shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and tribal laws and regulations, and with all Gila River Resorts & Casinos rules, policies, and procedures. This provision includes any public health laws, regulations, rules, policies, or procedures in effect at the time of the Conference, including any requirements related to communicable disease mitigation that may be instituted in advance of or during the event.

55. PROHIBITED PRACTICES:

Without limitation of the foregoing, the following are prohibited practices:

- Use of aisle space for display or promotional activity;
- Distribution of materials or literature other than information regarding the Sponsors own products and services;
- Distribution of materials or literature outside the Sponsors assigned booth
- Use of sound or light that disturbs neighboring exhibits;
- Use of entertainment; and
- Use of games, contests, lotteries, or other games of chance, except as described in the section titled "Giveaways and Drawings."

56. OFFICIAL VENDORS:

The Sponsor agrees that NTICC may share the Sponsors contact information with NTICC Annual Conference official vendors, including the general services contractor, audiovisual equipment vendor, internet provider, and electricity provider.

57. AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONAL RULES:

Any matters not specifically covered by this Agreement shall be subject solely to the decision of NTICC. At any time, NTICC may amend or add to these Terms and Conditions, and all such amendments or additions shall be binding on the Sponsor.

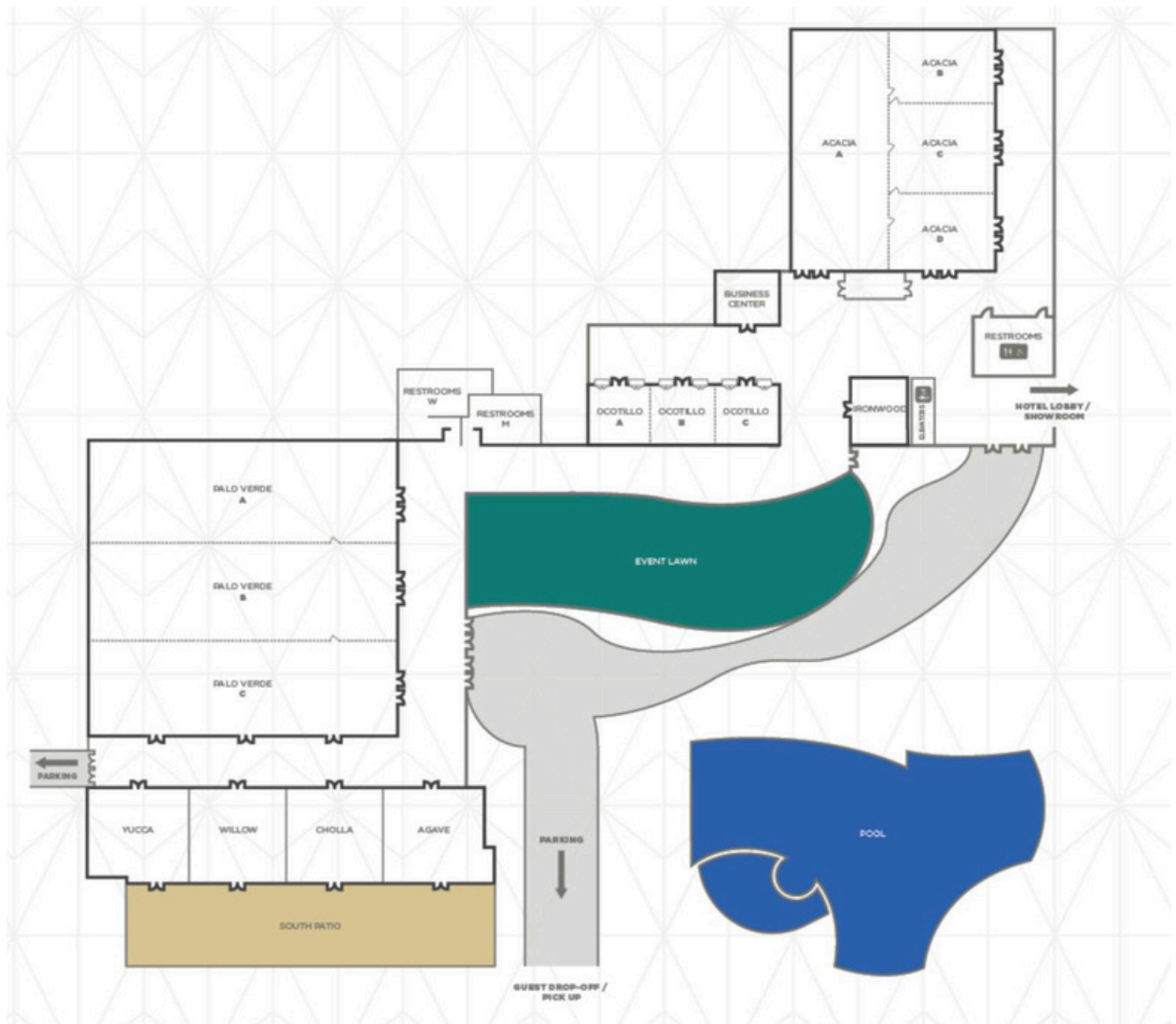

Pallets and skids should be fully wrapped in plastic and crate lids completely secured for shipment. Return shipment must be labeled, taped and ready for pick-up. Gila River Resorts & Casinos is not responsible for taping boxes, adhering labels, or scheduling pick-ups.

If labels are needed, our team has the ability to print these out for you. A \$2 per label charge will be applied. Packing materials are available for purchase in the Business Center.

All shipments are to be dropped off at the Business Center to be shipped out. Outgoing packages will not be picked up at vendor booths or in the event space. Pre-arranged pick-up for pallets, skids and crates can be confirmed directly with the Business Center Supervisor.

Vendors and Exhibitors must call the specific carrier to request pick-up for their shipments. If the shipment is time sensitive (next day or overnight) it should be taken directly to FedEx or UPS. For your convenience, the links below show the establishments nearest to Wild Horse Pass.
